4. At *The Relationship Between the Parties* section of their instant "Factual History," plaintiffs tell this court: "When a new laser became available on the market which Nevyas found to be an improvement over the previously available lasers, he purchased this laser for his own use and discontinued his IDE with the FDA."

Outside this court, the FDA shut down Nevyas' IDE "for reasons of public safety," forcing Nevyas to purchase an FDA-approved LASIK device. Among the 3500 pages of documents produced by Nevyas in the instant case, and the 900 pages produced in the earlier *Morgan v. Nevyas et al*, there is no document showing Nevyas voluntarily ended his IDE. Instead, after repeatedly citing problems with Nevyas and his IDE, and after repeatedly warning Nevyas about violations of law, regulation, and protocol, the FDA shut down Nevyas' IDE. *See* section 12 of Defendant Morgan's instant Memorandum of Law in Response.
